Summer Reading

Just like athletes who need to practice daily in order to improve their game, readers need to practice daily in order to improve their brains. Research shows that it is very important to read every day all summer long. Here are the Summer Reading Club Guidelines:

- Color in the squares (see reverse) for each day that you read for 15 minutes.
- Parents, grandparents, friends, and relatives may read to children who cannot yet read alone.
- You should read materials that are at your reading level: not too easy; not too hard; just right.

The Kindness Challenge

During the school year, we use PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) to cultivate a positive school climate and recognize and reward good behavior and effort. This summer, we challenge students to perform acts of kindness that will help to cultivate a positive climate in the community. Here are the guidelines for The Kindness Challenge:

- Perform 5 meaningful acts of kindness and place a check-mark in the grid (see reverse) for each act.
- With each act of kindness, reflect upon how your act has a positive effect on your community.
